DRAWING TO MUSIC: Gnossienne no.2

Interesting Fact:

Satie was a popular French composer whose music is often featured in ballet, theatre and cinema. This piece is one of his *Gnossiennes*, a series of piano pieces that are described as sombre and sad dances.

Discussion Points:
